The City of Ottawa is undertaking a feasibility study that examines options for reducing the number of lanes on King Edward Avenue between Rideau Street and Sussex Drive. As part of this work, an evaluation of the community and transportation impacts of three alternative lane configurations is being carried out.

Please join us at the Open House to review the findings to date and provide your feedback. **Your input is very important. It will help us understand your perspective on the King Edward Avenue corridor.**

The results of the study will be presented to Transportation Committee in May 2010. Recommendations will be based on study results as well as the feedback received from stakeholders during the Open House.

Given the recent reconstruction of King Edward Avenue, if a lane reduction alternative is determined to be feasible, the recommendation to Transportation Committee will also explain how a future lane reduction could be achieved in a cost-effective way and with minimal disruption to the community.
